1. VISITOR/Temp Badge remains property of the San Bernardino International Airport. VISITOR Badge shall be immediately surrendered to the Airport Operations Department upon request, and or at the end of the VISITOR Badge holder's visit.
2. A lost or stolen VISITOR Badge must be immediately reported to the Airport Operations Department.
3. VISITOR Badge holder agrees to abide by all applicable Federal, State, and City laws, and Airport Rules and Regulations while on Airport property as enforced by their ESCORT.
4. VISITOR Badge is non-transferrable, and is for the sole use of the individual specifically authorized and depicted on the VISITOR Badge. Loaning, or allowing use of a VISITOR Badge by other individuals is prohibited, and cause for immediate revocation of VISITOR Badge and removal from the airport.
5. Replacement cost for a lost, stolen, or damaged VISITOR Badge is \$40.00 per occurrence.
6. VISITOR Badge holder agrees to display the Security Badge on the outermost garment, between neck and waist, at all times while on airport property.
