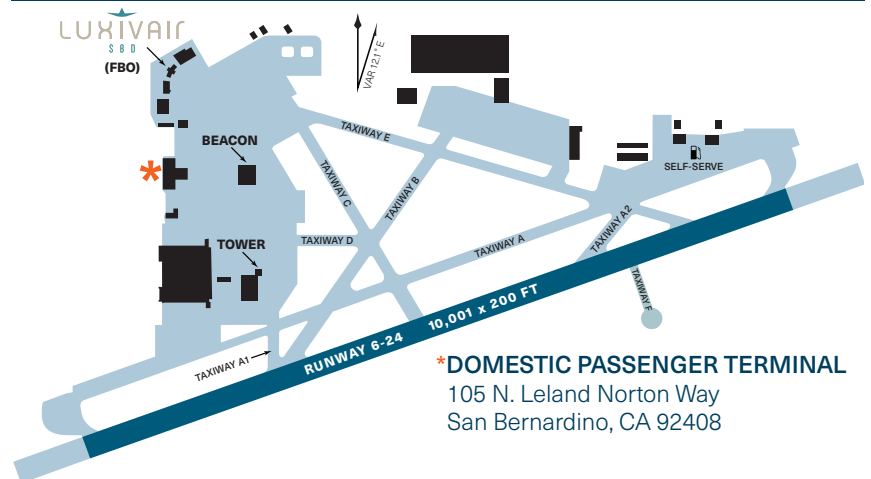




## Background Information
